

106. B.N. Mandal University, Bihar - Renewal of recognition of MS(OBG) qualification for 2 seats and DGO qualification for 1 seat and recognition of MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 2 to 4 seats in respect of students being trained at Kathiar Medical College, Kathiar.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (17/03/2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (September, 2015 & 18.05.2016) and compliance dated 25/10/2016 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition of MS(OBG) qualification for 2 seats and DGO qualification for 1 seat and Recognition of MS (OBG) qualification against increased intake from 2 to 4 seats at Kathiar Medical College, Kathiar granted by B.N. Mandal University, Bihar.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (17/03/2017) along with the Council Assessor's Report (September, 2015 & 18.05.2016) and compliance dated 25/10/2016 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that the recognition of MS(OBG) qualification for 2 seats and DGO qualification for 1 seat granted by B.N. Mandal University, Bihar in respect of students being trained at Kathiar Medical College, Kathiar be renewed.

The Committee also decided to recommend to the Central Government that the MS (OBG) qualification against increased intake from 2 to 4 seats granted by B.N. Mandal University, Bihar in respect of students being trained at Kathiar Medical College, Kathiar be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.
