ADA University, Azerbaijan

ADA University is dedicated to preparing innovative global leaders and to promoting useful collaborative research on diplomacy, public and international affairs, business, humanities and sciences, information technologies and system engineering. The university is officially accredited and recognized by the Ministry of Education of Azerbaijan.



Financial University, Russia






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University of Monterrey, Mexico

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Lecture on Global Education by Prof. Dr. Nick Gee, Bishop Grosseteste University, UK, at SOE

Prof. Dr. Nick Gee from Bishop Grosseteste University, UK has visited Sharda University in February 2020 invited by International Relations Division. During his visit Dr. Gee had meetings with Sharda University officials regarding educational partnership between Sharda University and Bishop Grosseteste University and delivered a lecture on Education for further studies abroad in the School of Education.

Prof. Dr. Gee is the Dean of Faculty at Bishop Grosseteste University, with responsibility for academic delivery of the University strategy. He studied Geography at Oxford University, and completed a Doctorate at the University of East Anglia. His current research interests include outdoor education, subject knowledge, notions of community and progression into higher education and he also has expertise in geographical fieldwork. Prof. Dr. Gee has authored over 70 scholarly/ academic journal articles, contributed to chapters in academic and professional texts and acted as a consultant for GCSE, A level,

undergraduate and postgraduate textbooks. He has undertaken funded research for the East of England Development Education Network and the College of West Anglia, and currently leads a British Councilfunded (2019-21) international student mobility project. In 2018 Nick was invited by the British Embassy Bangkok, The Department for International Trade and the Teachers' Council of Thailand to deliver specialist input on the importance of subject knowledge to inform the Southeast Asia Teachers Competency Framework. He holds a Visiting Professorship at Nakhon Ratchasima Rajabhat University and has undertaken a variety of partnership, knowledge exchange and recruitment activities in China, Cyprus, Hong Kong, India, Ireland, Lithuania, the Netherlands & Thailand. The visit and lecture by Prof. Dr. Gee was one more step for the internationalization of Sharda University as per the vision of Honorable Chancellor Mr. P. K. Gupta to make Sharda India's global university.

Visit of Vice-President of Sacred Heart University, Connecticut, USA

Dr. Rupendra Paliwal, Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs of Sacred Heart University at Fairfield, Connecticut, USA, visited Sharda University on Monday the 6th of January 2020 invited by International Relations Division as a part of Honorable Chancellor Mr. P.K. Gupta vision to make Sharda University India's first global university. During the visit the two universities agreed to proceed with collaboration in Business, Computer Science and Engineering and Technology including student and faculty exchange programs, faculty development, joint research programs, joint teaching projects, study abroad programs, summer programs and executive development programs.

Sacred Heart University was founded in 1963. The university offers more than 80-degree programs to over 8,500 students at the bachelor's, master's and doctoral levels. The university consists of five colleges: College of Arts & Sciences, which includes the School of Communication & Media Arts and the School of
