

The 41 UP Battalion (Bulandshahar) organized the camp.


The Camp attracted 800 cadets, followed by 250 girl cadets and rest boy cadets. Cadets followed a strict ten-day schedule.
















All About CATC 130 Camp @ Sharda University






Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat camp








FIRING CAMP 2021




Armed forces flag Day and NCC Fresher's Orientation






Republic Day 2022
