In accordance with the feedback received from the students pertaining to the optional course titled Introduction to Visual Arts (BEP 204) taught in B.A(H) English, Term III, it was found that the course required massive dilution in the nature of its contents to suit the receptive capacity of the students. Hence, it has been decided to drop the course unanimously from the curriculum.

The course titled Introduction to Film Studies (BEP 207), earlier an optional paper in the old curriculum of B.A(H) English, has been added to the list of Core Courses in the new curriculum of B.A(H) English as per CBCS scheme. This course will be taught in Term V. The change has been undertaken keeping in mind the rising popularity of film studies as an academic discipline across major universities in the country.

III. Generic Electives / Open Electives of 2 credits have been introduced in Term II, III, IV, and V. The students are free to opt for a course of their preference out of the array of courses offered by other schools of the University.

- i. We have proposed OBE (Outcome Based Document) document for M.A. English programme.
- ii. All the course modules have been modified to highlight course outcome against every unit & sub unit. Unit five in paper (MAE 114 New Literatures in English) has been modified. Chinua Achebe's Novel Things Fall Apart has been replaced by Arundhati Roy's Novel The God of Small Things, as Things Fall Apart is prescribed in B.A. (Hons.) English Semester-5. The change has been made to avoid repetetion. The content of other papers has not been changed.
