As mentioned in Para 11.9 of NEP'20 the undergraduate degree programme will be of 3 or 4 years duration, with multiple exit options within this period, with appropriate certifications, e.g., a certificate after completing 1 year, in a discipline or field including vocational and professional areas, or a diploma after 2 years of study, or a Bachelor's degree after a 3-year programme. The 4-year multidisciplinary Bachelor's programme, however, shall be the preferred option since it allows the opportunity to experience the full range of holistic and multidisciplinary education in addition to a focus on the chosen major and minors as per the choices of the student.

We would also consider the Inter University Migration by accepting credits stored at ABC (Academic Bank credit) as & when it would be established as laid down in NEP'20.

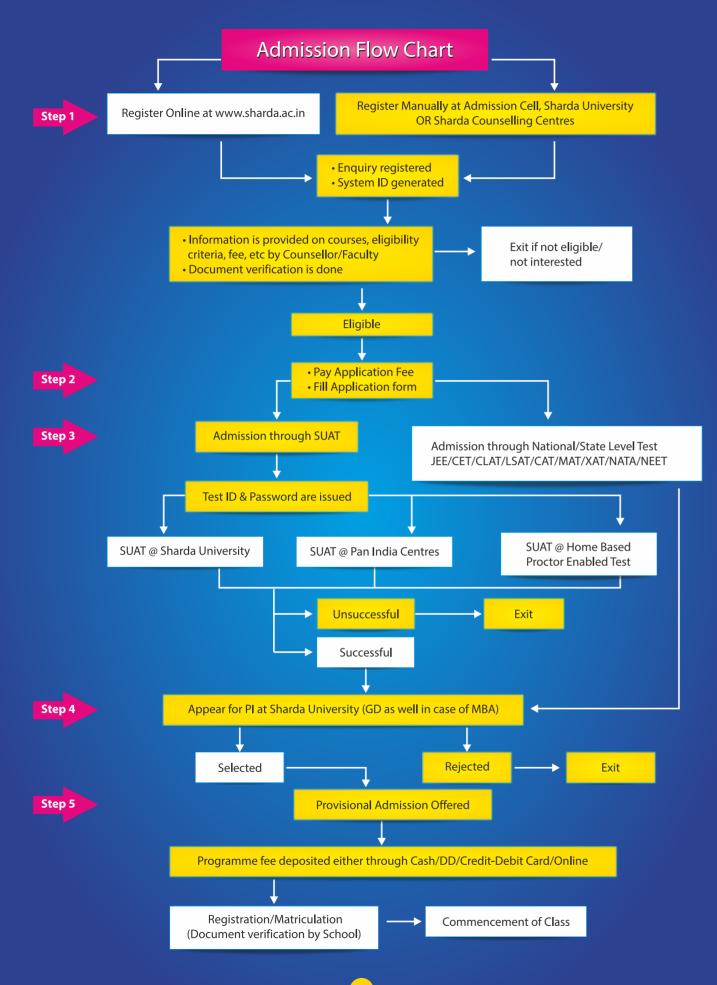
