Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in English is a three year degree course offered by School of Languages and Culture. Students who are proficient in English communication and have passed Sr. secondary (10+2) with 50% marks from a recognized board are eligible for this course. The course not only sets in a base for higher academic degree in English literature but also enables students to gain a certain set of skills namely reading skill, Phonetics, creative writing, critical thinking, analytical thinking, understanding of relationship between literature and cinema, literature and culture and so on. It is highly relevant in the context of an ever expanding base of professions based on English studies.

Students who opt to become teachers need to pursue a B.Ed. degree or M.Ed. degree. Those who are interested in research can opt for the Doctoral degree. With the PhD degree, one can apply for the position of University lecturer. The career as a translator is also quite lucrative.

B.A. (Hons.) History is a 3-year undergraduate course, the minimum eligibility for which is a 10+2 qualification. The programme aims to build in eligible students basic and advanced lessons in the discipline of History, The most obvious skill that you get from a history degree is a thorough understanding of historic events and facts. You'll know, or at least have a general idea for, the significant names, dates, and events that shaped our collective history, both here in the United States and globally.

Although entry-level positions are available for those with bachelor's degrees, the majority of significant political science careers and research positions are available to those with graduate degrees only.

CAREER AFTER M.A. IN ENGLISH LITERATURE



With experience, candidates can get jobs with national as well as international magazines such as Vogue, National Geographic Magazine etc. Moreover, students can also go for higher studies. They can pursue M.Phil., Ph.D. or MBA. Social work as well as advertising fields also require students with flair for writing. Those candidates who have good skills in writing can find employment as campaign managers, speech writers and other positions that require the sophisticated use of written and spoken English. 
