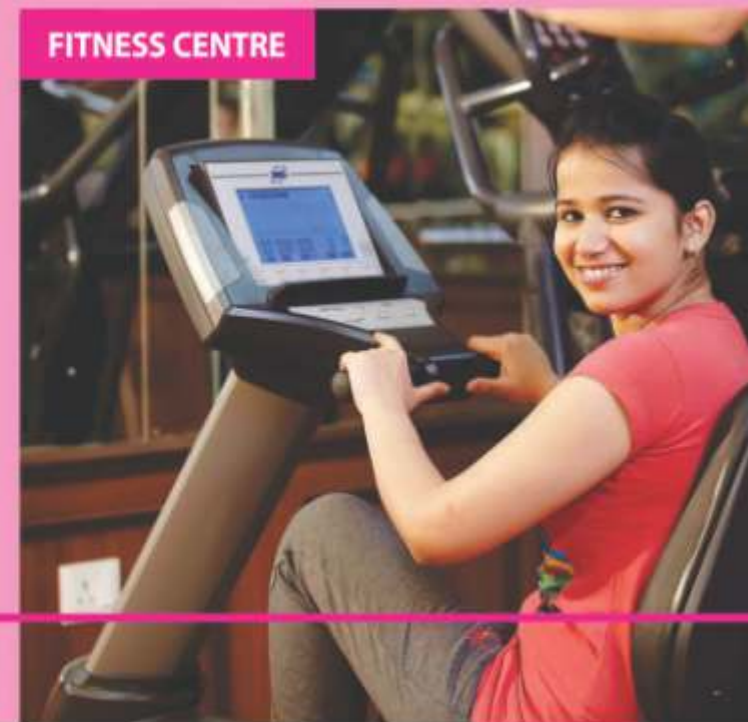

BACHELOR IN PHARMACY (B.PHARM.)

Minimum qualification for admission

First year B.Pharm.:

Candidate should have passed 10+2 examination conducted by the respective state/central government authorities recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (P.C.M) and or Biology (P.C.B / P.C.M.B.) as optional subjects individually with minimum 50% marks or any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

B. Pharm. lateral entry (to third semester):

A pass in D. Pharm. course from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

Duration of the programme

The course of study for B.Pharm. shall extend over a period of eight semesters (four academic years) and six semesters (three academic years) for lateral entry students. The curricula and syllabi for the programme shall be prescribed from time to time by Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi.

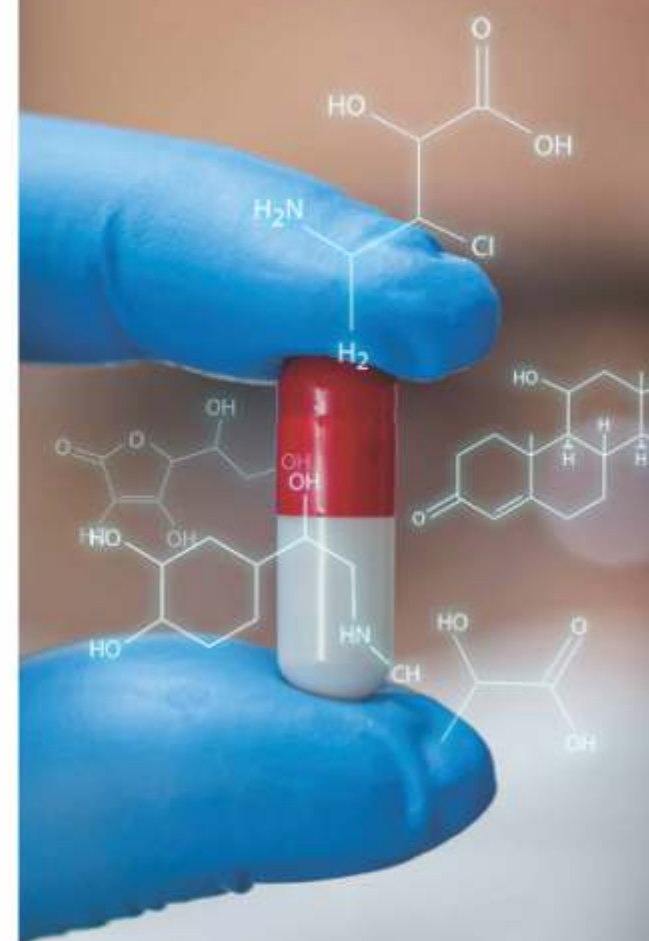

Ph.D IN PHARMACY



Eligibility: The applicant must have obtained M.Pharm. degree or equivalent degree with first division from an institution recognized by the University and Pharmacy Council of India, in any of the specialization in Pharmacy.

DIPLOMA IN PHARMACY (D.PHARM.)

Eligibility:

Minimum qualification for admission to Diploma in Pharmacy is passed in any of the following examinations with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics.

1. Intermediate examination in Science,
2. The first year of the three year degree course in Science,
3. 10+2 examination (academic stream) in Science; with minimum 50% marks.
4. Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examination.

Provided that there shall be reservation of seats for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes candidates in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Govt./ State Govts./ Union Territory Admns. as the case may be from time to time.

Duration of the course:

The duration of the course shall be for two academic years with each academic year spread over a period of not less than one hundred and eighty working days in addition to 500 hours practical training spread over a period of not less than 3 months.

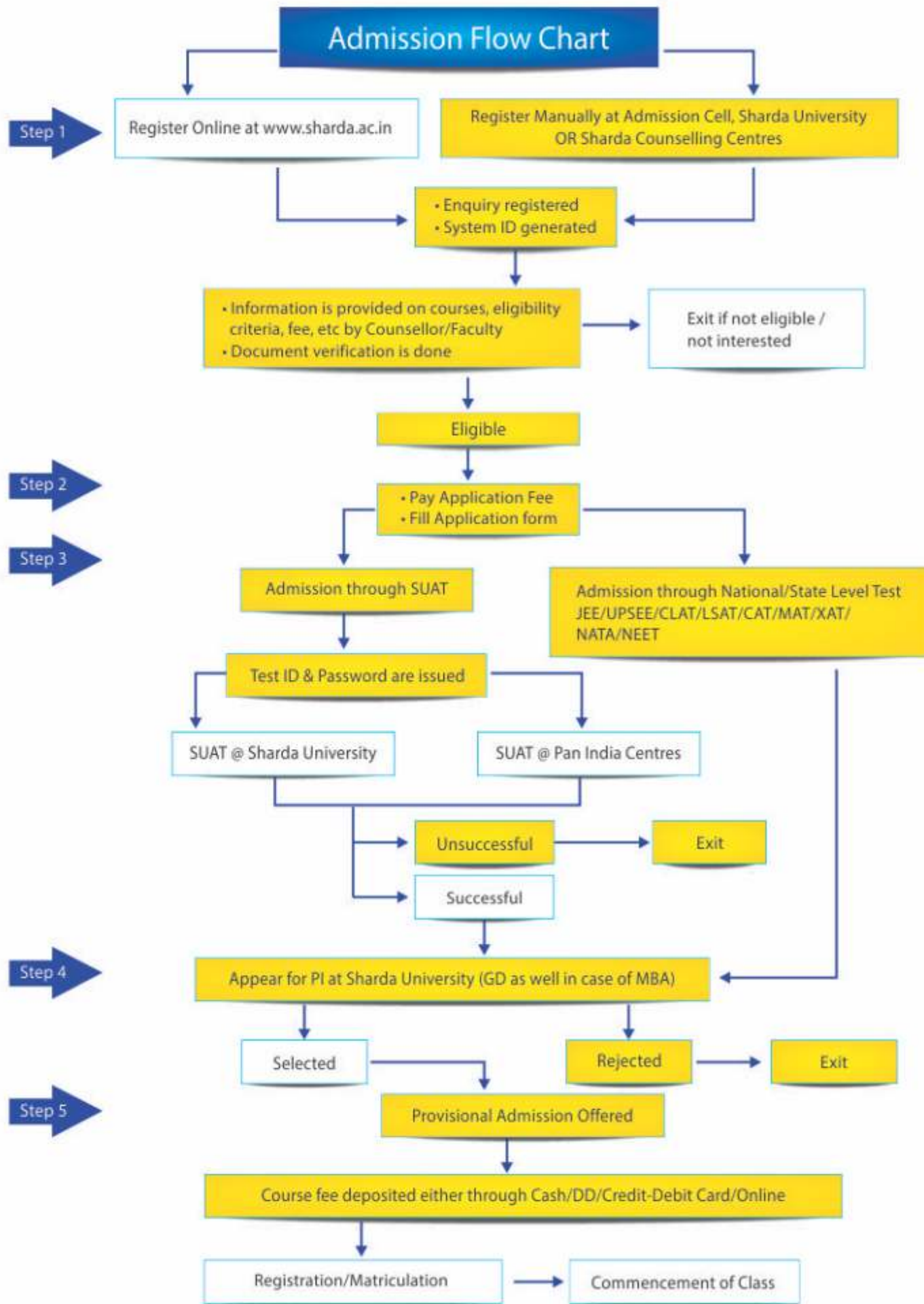
