conducted on 18th and 19th January 2017 by Fine Arts Club of Sharda Cultural, Technical and Sports Society

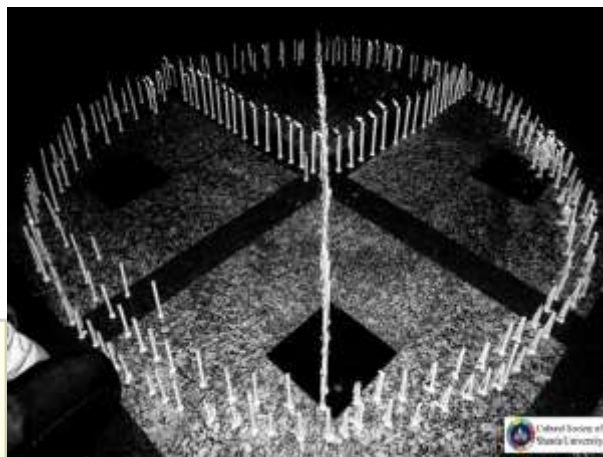
