
## Independence Day - (15<sup>th</sup> August 2018)

### **North East Cultural Programme- (28th September 2018)**


This is one of the cultural programs which are providing a platform to the students belonging to the North East in which they will present their culture and share their art among us.




## GNIDA Winter Carnival-( 27 January 2019)
