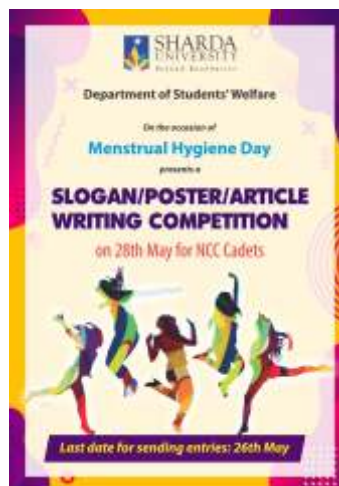

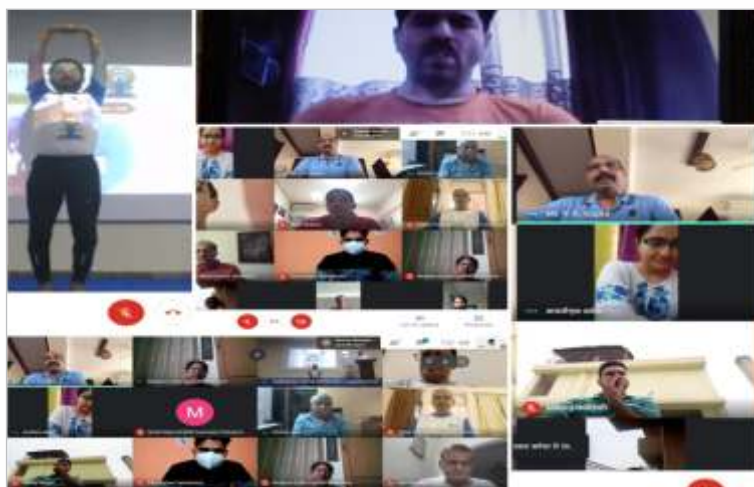

Yoga at Home & Yoga with Family': UGC Recommendation for Universities, Colleges

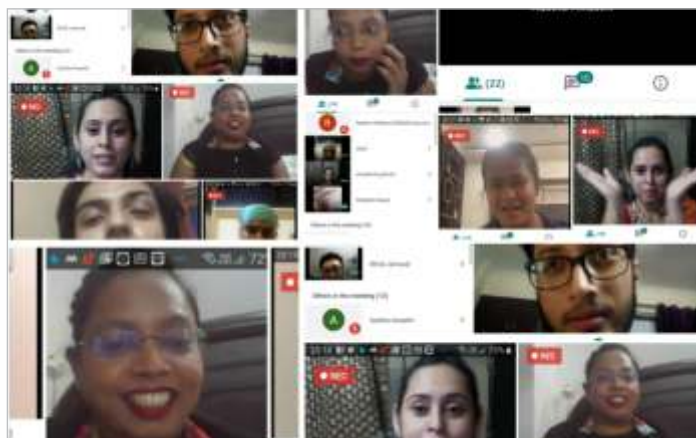

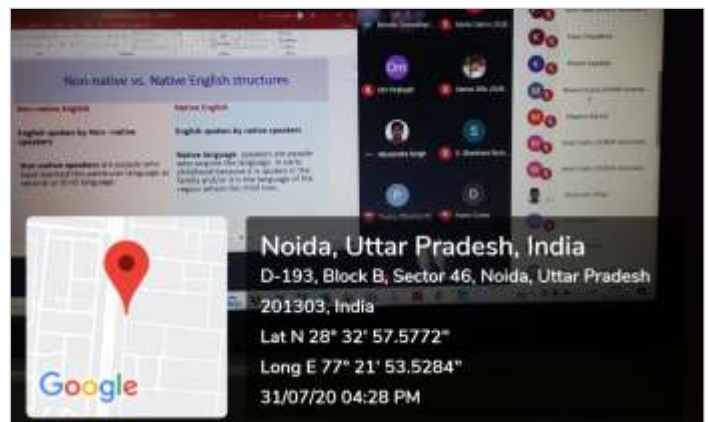
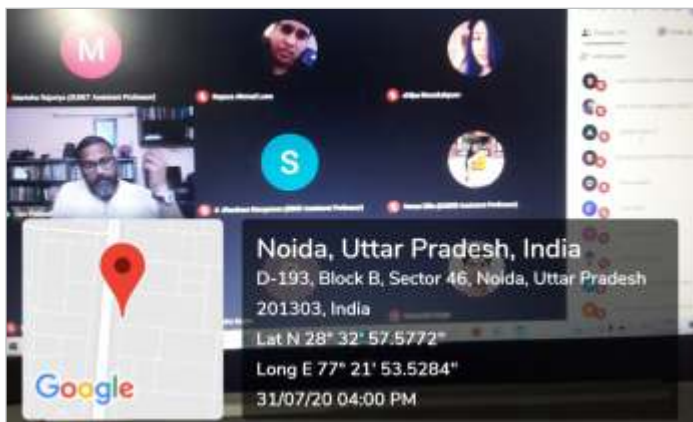


Online webinar on “English Literature and Language” (31st July 2020)

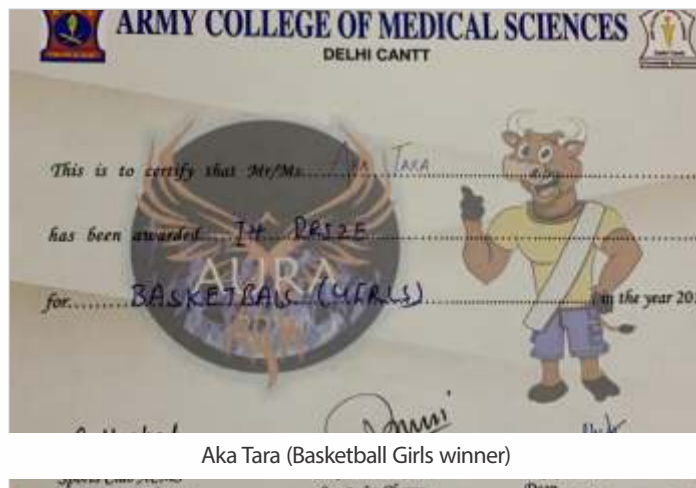
