NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF OPEN SCHOOLING



NIOS is "Open School" to cater to the needs of a heterogeneous group of learners up to pre-degree level. It was started as a project with in-built flexibilities by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) in 1979. In 1986, the National Policy on Education suggested strengthening of Open School System for extending open learning facilities in a phased manner at secondary level all over the country as an independent system with its curriculum and examination leading to certification.

Consequently, the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India set up the National Open School (NOS) in November 1989. The pilot project of CBSE on Open School was amalgamated with NOS. Through a resolution (No. F.5-24/90 Sch.3 dated 14 September 1990 published in the Gazette of India on 20 October 1990), the National Open School (NOS) was vested with the authority to register, examine and certify students registered with it up to pre-degree level courses. In July 2002, the Ministry of Human Resource Development amended the nomenclature of the organisation from the National Open School (NOS) to the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) with a mission to provide relevant continuing education at school stage, up to pre-degree level through Open Learning system to prioritized client groups as an alternative to formal system, in pursuance of the normative national policy documents and in response to the need assessments of the people, and through it to make its share of contribution to Universalisation of education to greater equity and justice in society, and to the evolution of a learning society.

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) are gaining attraction all over the world to provide unlimited participation and open access to quality education through web. The visitors to the top three MOOCs platforms (Udemy, Coursera, and edX) are from the United States, followed by visitors from India. This shows the tangible interest of MOOCs in India with their cost-effectiveness and potential to reach a large number of learners. MOOCs provide us the opportunity to broaden access to quality education at all levels.

This workshop will discuss the platforms available for launching MOOCs and the problems/challenges involved in the course delivery, develop skills for designing and delivering courses through the network of individuals and institutions, highlight the research in the related field as they have given Indian academics a better sense of how a lecture could be restructured into short, self-contained segments with high interactivity to engage students more effectively.

- To train the participants to use MOOCs as an adjunct to face-to-face teaching and to teach in a fully online or distance learning context.

- To create better and active communication and collaboration with the students and to design and manage learning assessment using MOOCs Platform.
