ARTICLE WRITING COMPETITION

Rules for Article Writing Competition:

- Only one Article can be submitted by each Participant.
- Student can write Articles only in Hindi language.
- Time allotted is 45 minutes.
- Participants will be provided with the sheets and pens during the competition.
- The work should be original and handmade, no external sources should be referred to during the competition. Previously published Articles are excluded. Any form of plagiarism will result in disqualification.
- Content of the Article should not be obscene or hurt any religious, linguistic, or social sentiment.

Judgement Criteria-

An independent panel of Judges shall be formed from Sharda University to judge the entries. Each Article shall be evaluated out of 100 marks. The decision of the judges shall be final. Judgement will be based on:

- Relevance to the theme (20 %)
- Originality (20 %)
- Creativity (20 %)
- Artistic composition (20 %)
- Message conveyed in the poster (20 %)

- 1st Prize Winner Rs 1500
- 2nd Prize Winner Rs 1000
- 3rd Prize Winner Rs 500

RECITATION COMPETITION

Rules for Recitation Competition:

- Only one Recitation can be recited by each Participant.
- Recitation can be of song or poetry, Recitation of views on the themes etc.
- Time limit for Recitation is maximum 5 minutes for each participant.
- Recitation should be related but not limited to India.
- Content of the Recitation should not be obscene or hurt any religious, linguistic, or social sentiment.

Judgement Criteria-

An independent panel of Judges shall be formed from Sharda University to judge the entries. Each Recitation shall be evaluated out of 100 marks. The decision of the judges shall be final. Judgement will be based on:

- Relevance (20 %)
- Originality and Creativity (20 %)
- Content and Composition (20 %)
- Speech and Language (20 %)
- Message conveyed in the Article (20 %)

Prize Money -

- 1st Prize Winner Rs 1500
- 2nd Prize Winner Rs 1000
- 3rd Prize Winner Rs 500
