EVENT DETAILS

Cabinet approved National Education Policy 2020 on 29th July 2020, claiming an immense move in the education system of the country from pre-primary to the level of doctorate degree. University Grants Commission (UGC) has suggested to create awareness about the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

As per UGC, there is a need to create awareness about NEP 2020 amongst teachers, students, officials, and other stakeholders in the higher education system. In order to reach out to all the stakeholders in the higher education system, the UGC has desired higher educational institutions to use various platforms for the dissemination of the NEP 2020. Honourable Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi has made an appeal to academic community, to have wider discussions and to explore the opportunities and effective ways to implement the policy. The targeted big changes have brought some mixed feelings among the stakeholders. Some provisions of the policy are promising a bright future but at the same time, huge institutional transformation is also causing apprehensions. This is the biggest proposed change in education sector, whose implementation will be a great challenge. In a significant shift from the 1986 policy, which pushed for a 10+2 structure of school education, the new NEP pitches for a "5+3+3+4" design corresponding to the age groups 3-8 years (foundational stage), 8-11 (preparatory), 11-14 (middle), and 14-18 (secondary)
