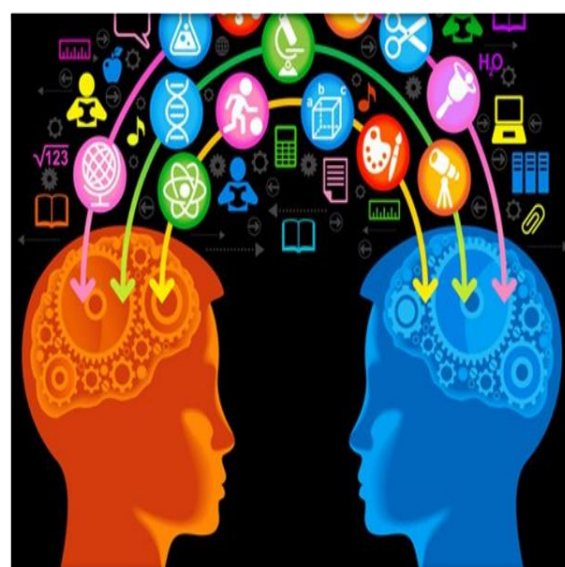


OUTCOME BASED TEACHING LEARNING PROCESSES

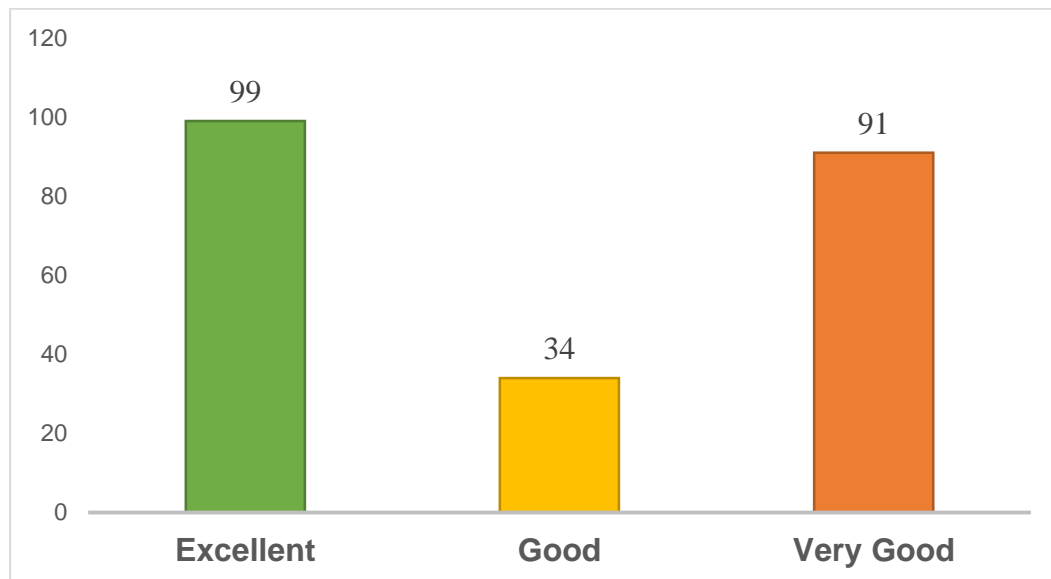

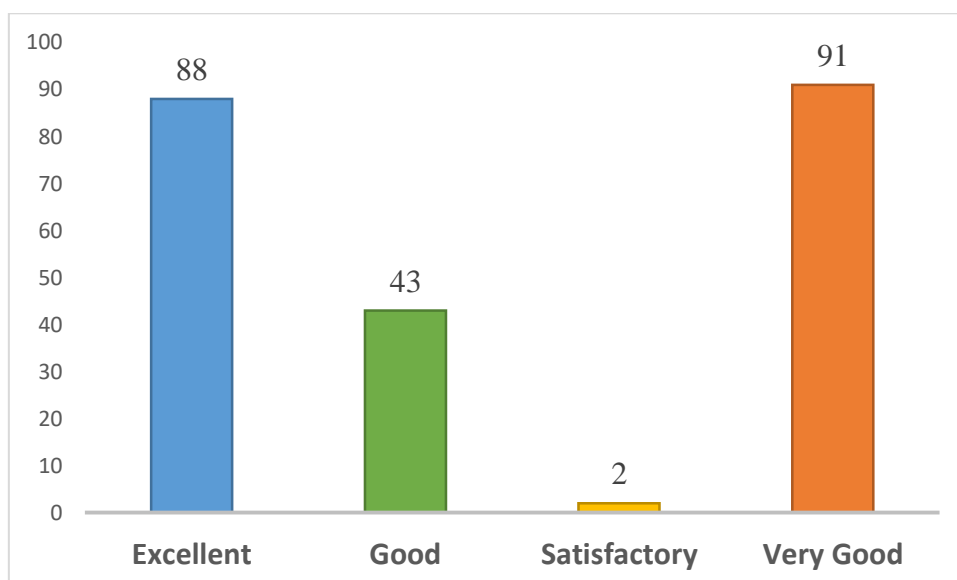

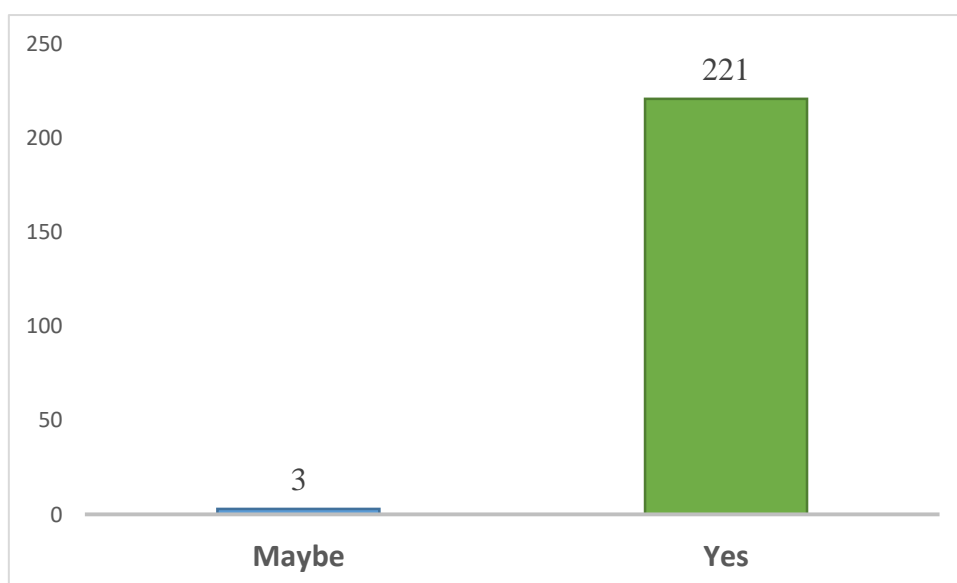
