1. Event objectives-

The Primary objectives of this FDP are:

- a) AI and its role in Healthcare.
- b) Application of AI in drug discovery and Research.
- c) Ethical and legal aspects of AI

1. Event description:

The IQAC of Sharda University organized a 5-day International Faculty Development Program (FDP) on Digital Healthcare and Emerging Technologies from March 26-31, 2025. The event was held under the guidance of the esteemed Vice-Chancellor, Professor Sibaram Khara, and the head of CAIMIF, Professor Ashok Kumar. The FDP was conducted by Dr. Kumud Madan (member of IQAC) and Professor Sanju Tiwari (member of CAIMIF).

The program featured discussions with experts including Dr. Manas Gaur from the University of Maryland, Baltimore County, USA; Dr. Niranjan Chitare from Birmingham City University, UK; Dr. Ashok Kumar and Dr. Sunita Sharma from Sharda University; Professor T.K. Srikanth from IIIT Bangalore; Dr. Ghanapriya Singh from NIT Kurukshetra; Dr. Shilpa Srivastava from Christ University; and Dr. Stratos Kontopoulos from the Food Pairing Industry in Greece, along with Mr. Anand Panchbhai from Logic.AI India.

The sessions primarily focused on mental health, where discussions on the role of Artificial Intelligence were led by Dr. Ghanapriya Singh, Dr. Shilpa Srivastava, Dr. Manas Gaur, and Professor T.K. Srikanth. Dr. Niranjan Chitare emphasized security aspects aimed at preventing large-scale cyberattacks on healthcare, sharing cases from the UK. Dr. Stratos highlighted the role of Artificial Intelligence in dietary systems, while Dr. Ashok discussed its significance in healthcare. Dr. Sunita focused on the impact of AI in drug discovery, and Dr. Anand Panchbhai concentrated on general intelligence and superintelligence in medical imaging, illustrating his points with an example from dental imaging. The insights provided by the distinguished speakers paved the way for new horizons.

Various participants from diverse fields attended the FDP. They expressed appreciation for the engaging sessions and interactive learning opportunities, with many highlighting the program's impact on promoting interdisciplinary research and technological innovation in healthcare. Sharda University is moving forward to promote innovation and excellence in digital healthcare and emerging technologies.
















3. Event Agenda



The FDP is purported to disseminate knowledge through deliberations of various resource people having expertise in this field.




