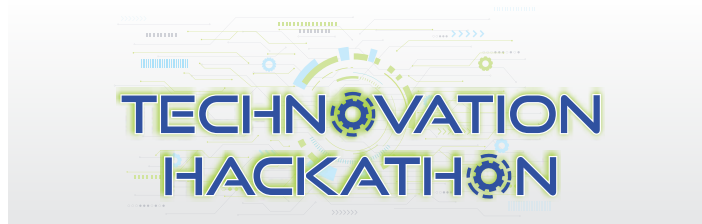

SHARDA UNIVERSITY STUDENTS WIN TOP PRIZE IN



Sharda University organized a 24-hour Hackathon titled "Technovation Hackathon" in association with GNIDA as a part of the Winter Carnival of Greater Noida industrial Development Authority. The themes of this Hackathon were Waste Management, Security and Surveillance, Smart Transportation and Traffic Management, and Energy Efficiency & Green Energy.

More than 400 students came together at the first "Technovation Hackathon"- 24hour hackathon organised by School of Engineering and Technology, Sharda University, in association with GNIDA. On the occasion of 28th Foundation Day of GNIDA, the event brought together students from across 30 different colleges and universities from different states of the country with an aim to ideate and create innovative solutions for some of the critical issues faced by the people of Greater Noida.

A panel consisting of 8 Senior Experts from distinct industries evaluated the projects. The first prize winner of INR 50,000, followed by winners across four themes got INR 30,000, INR 20,000 and INR 10,000 per theme respectively. Anubhav Kumar Singh,

Samiksha Singh and Atif Anwar of Sharda University won the top prize of Rs. 50,000/- for their innovative idea under the theme of Security & Surveillance.

Community mapping project undertaken by Sharda students

Students of BA Honours (1st year- SEM I) undertook a sociological qualitative research approach based community mapping project at Sharda University campus. The idea behind the project was to acquaint the students in the 'field' and help them practice sociological theory in their own community. Various stakeholders were interviewed through a questionnaire and theoretical apparatus

was used to understand and present the data collected by the students. The students did not only learn how to collect data and understand the very dynamic nature of 'data' but also develop rapport in the field. Their interaction with various social groups working or residing inside the university- such as the laundry service providers, construction workers, hospital staff, security guards and food-stall kiosk service providers enriched their sociological understanding of the society they form social relationship with. All the students made a power point presentation, some of them used a power-point for the very first time, of their projects and selected few volunteered to hold a public presentation for the department. Their research was well-received and appreciated by the audience. The rich ethnographic data gathered by students displayed their extreme enthusiasm & the nuance understanding of their very social system.

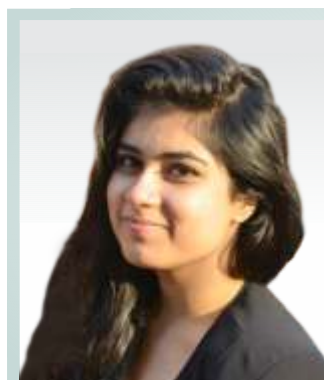
