Nursing is a four-year undergraduate programme focused on developing critical care professionals with advance thinking skills and values necessary for the practice of nursing and midwifery profession as mentioned in the National Health Policy 2003. The programme is streamlined to enable students to address the health needs of the nation, society and individuals.

The programme prepares students to become responsible citizens by following a code of moral values and conduct at all times while fulfilling personal, social and professional responsibilities to respond to national objectives.

B.Sc. Nursing programme involves classroom study, projects and assignments that enable students to gain practical knowledge of their learning. After the completion of the programme, students are required to undergo a six-month internship to experience real-world clinical settings and learn from them. Candidates looking for more knowledge in the same field may pursue higher education for challenging career opportunities.

Duration: 4 Years

Eligibility Criteria:

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- Minimum education:
- A candidate should have passed in the subjects of PCB

and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in PCB at the qualifying examination (10+2).

- Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having science subjects and English only.
- A candidate belonging to SC/ST or other backward classes, the marks obtained in PCB taken together in qualifying examination be 40% instead of 45% as stated above.
- English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc. (N)
- Student shall be medically fit.

Entrance/Selection test:

Selection of the candidate is based on the merit of the entrance examination held by University or competent authority.



Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing (PB-B.Sc.) is a two-year graduate programme designed to inculcate an in-depth understanding of advanced level nursing. Under this programme aspirants brush up their learning to provide complete medical care to the patients. The students acquire both surgical and non-surgical nursing skills that prepare them for varied real-world clinical and hospital settings.

The programme prepares students to take independent decisions in nursing situations and play a major role in treating patients with care and compassion. The programme curriculum comprises subjects like Maternal Nursing, Medical & Surgical Nursing, Microbiology and Mental Health Nursing.

The broad area of the study involves Introduction to Nursing Research & Statistics which enables them to solve problems related to nursing using scientific methods.

The programme transmutes students to industry-trained professionals with a strong understanding of the philosophy, objectives and responsibilities of nursing as a profession.

Duration-2Years

Eligibility Criteria:

 Obtained a certificate in General Nursing and Midwifery and registered as R.N.R.M. with the State Nurses Registration Council. A male nurse, trained before the implementation of the new integrated course besides being registered as a nurse with State Nurses Registration Council, shall produce evidence of training approved by Indian Nursing Council for a similar duration in lieu of midwifery in any one of the following areas:

This is a three-year job-oriented programme aimed to train students to closely assess the nursing need of the patients, provide effective nursing care and assist the doctors in surgical procedures. The students learn to set up medical equipment in operation theatres and adeptly handle patients during emergency situations.

The aspirants are additionally trained to be job-ready by imbibing computer and interpersonal skills. After successful completion of the programme the students are enrolled for an internship.

Duration: 3 Years

Eligibility Criteria: Minimum education eligibility criteria for admission to GNM:

- 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually for any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However, Science is preferable.
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing council.
- 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from a recognized CBSE board/Centre.
- Registered ANM with pass mark.

For Foreign Nationals

The entry qualification equivalency i.e., 12th standard will be

obtained by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. Institution, State Nursing Council will be responsible to ensure that the qualification and eligibility will be equivalent to what has been prescribed as above.

- Students shall be medically fit.
- Minimum age for admission will be 17 years. (as on 31st December of that year) The upper age limit is 35 yrs. For ANM/for LHV, there is no age bar.

Reservation: For disabled candidates: 3% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for each nursing programme.

Note: A committee to be formed consisting of medical officer authorized by medical board of state government and a nursing expert in the panel which may decide whether the candidates have the disability of locomotor of 40% to 50%.

- 5% is relaxed for SC/ST candidates.
- Any other quotas as per the State Govt. under the reservation policy.

Note: Quotas shall be included in the seats sanctioned and not above it.



M.Sc. in Nursing is a two-year graduate programme meticulously structured to impart in-depth advance knowledge of nursing, methodologies and principles. The programme encompasses subjects like Advance Nursing, Practice Clinical Specialty and Nursing Management that trains the students to administer the activities of hospitals clinics and assist the staff in carrying out their duties effectively.

M.Sc. in Nursing programme prepares students to work collaboratively, evaluate data, interpret results, think vitally, draw logical conclusions and make composite decisions. The curriculum of the programme gives students the opportunities to devise plausible solutions to real-life situations and nursing challenges in an active learning environment.

Under this programme the candidates also learn about the ethical and legal aspects of nursing in the healthcare sector. In addition the emphasis is placed on imparting insights on the commonalities in a variety of diseases. Aspirants also gain a deep understanding of the relationship between diseases and symptoms that help them in identifying the problem.

Ph.D. in Nursing is a research-based Doctorate degree. This course entails conducting Nursing Research to improve healthcare facilities. The highest level of study a nursing student can attain is Ph.D in Nursing. It is an outstanding intellectual accomplishment that, when used, has the power to alter the healthcare system for the benefit of people.

Ph.D in Nursing is a research-oriented doctoral degree that emphasizes top-notch, academic research that promotes both nursing education and the nursing profession as a whole. Nursing scholars who will contribute to the development and application of knowledge for improving the quality of nursing education, research, service, and dissemination are prepared through doctoral study.

Eligibility criteria for admission to Ph.D. degree in Sharda University

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

Student fulfilling the following criteria shall be eligible for admission.

1 Students for admission to the Ph.D. programme shall have a Master's degree in concerned discipline or' a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency, which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority,

established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

- 2 A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed to the students belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/differently abled and other categories of candidates as per the Government notification, adopted by the University, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55 % (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above is permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.
- 3 In case of Medical and Dental Sciences, where percentage of marks is not given/ not mentioned in MD/MDS degree certificate, students possessing such degree certificate will also be considered for admission to Ph.D. programme on the approval of the Vice Chancellor.

DURATTON OF THE Ph.D. PROGRAMME:

- 1 Ph.D. programme shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of six years from the date of admission.
- 2 Extension beyond the maximum limit can be given up to a

maximum of two years for recorded reasons by the Vice Chancellor on the recommendations of SRC and Dean Research and Development.

3 The female candidates and persons with disability (more than 40%) may be allowed an additional relaxation of maximum two years' duration. In addition, the female candidates may be provided upto 240 days' relaxation for maternity/child care once in the entire duration of Ph.D

PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION:

- 1 Entrance Test followed by an interview shall be conducted by the University twice a year, normally in January and July. The weightage for entrance test and interview shall be 70% and 30% respectively. Only those students securing at least 50% marks in written examination and 50% marks in interview separately shall be considered for admission.
- 2 Students with M.Phil. degree or equivalent degree from any Institute/University recognized by UGC or qualified with fellowship/ scholarship offered by the University, National and international Agency / NET/ GATE score shall be exempted from entrance test. However, such students will have to appear for the interview, along with the students who have qualified the entrance test.
- 3 Foreign students who fulfill eligibility criteria will be admitted after an online test/interview.
- 4 Persons who are in regular employment in Academic Institutions, Research institute/ Corporate/ Industry / Public Undertaking / Government Sector, at a level not less than the level equivalent to Assistant Professor, and having five years of experience will be eligible for admission through specially conducted entrance test followed by interview
- 5 University shall decide on biannual basis a manageable number of Ph.D. students to be admitted in different Departments/ Schools based on the number of available eligible supervisors and academic / research facilities, keeping in mind the norms regarding the scholar-teacher ratio, laboratory, library and other facilities.
- 6 The admission shall be based on the criteria notified by the university, keeping in view the guidelines/ norms prescribed by the UGC and other discipline specific statutory bodies.
- 7 The university shall admit students by a two stage process (i) an entrance test conducted by Controller of Examination (COE) and (ii) an interview in the subject area of the candidate to be conducted by a committee constituted by Dean Research and Development.

- 8 The entrance test shall have two sections for a total of 70 Marks.
- (i) Core subject (50 MCQs)
- (ii) Research aptitude (20 MCQs)

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

COURSEWORK-

1 Each student admitted with a Master's degree shall complete a minimum of 16 credits of course work for his/her Ph.D. programme. This would include courses on Research Methodology (04 credits), Research and Publication Ethics (02 credits), and Pedagogy (02 Credits) as compulsory

In addition, the student will take, with the approval of the DRC and SRC, eight (8) credits course (02 courses each of 4 credits) on core courses or the Advanced Independent Study (AIS, 08 credits), which involves studying, understanding and submission of a review of 30 recently published quality research papers from reputed Journals in the concerned subject area in consultation with the supervisor.

The student has to make a presentation for its evaluation as per the guidelines given by the SRC. Based on AIS, publication of one review article is expected.

- 2 All courses of study shall be at post-Master's degree level, and will need the approval of DRC and SRC for course registration.
- 3 All students admitted to the Ph.D. programme shall be required to complete the course work during the initial one or two semesters.
- 4 A Ph.D. student has to obtain a minimum CCPA of 6.0 in the course work in order to be eligible to Register for Ph.D. and continue in the programme. However, each student is required to get a minimum of 50% marks each in CA and ETE/AIS separately.
- 5 Students already holding M.Phil. degree and admitted to the Ph.D. programme may be exempted from the Ph.D. course work if they have already done the same, but have to do Research and Publication Ethics and Pedagogy courses of 2 credits each.
- 6 Respective school shall be responsible for teaching of core papers/AIS, while Research Development Cell shall conduct Research Methodology, Research and Publication Ethics, and Pedagogy.




