## Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)

The Bachelor of Education programme, generally known as B.Ed. is approved by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE). It is a professional course that prepares teachers for upper primary or middle level (VI-VIII), secondary level (classes XI –XII). It is a skill based programme focused on global trends regarding student-teacher education which facilitates a deep understanding of global competitiveness, academic strength including e-learning, teaching skills, experience of the school environment, work culture and providing hands on and hands off experiences to prepare the students for classroom teaching. It offers a comprehensive coverage of themes and rigorous field engagement with the child, school and community.

### Duration

The duration of B.Ed. programme is of two academic years, which can be completed in a maximum of three years from the date of admission to the programme. The two years are structured in a way that the courses are taught not only through classroom learning but also through practical experience during internship (20 weeks) in schools and society.

### Eligibility criteria for B. Ed. (Bachelor of Education)

Graduation with minimum 50% marks. Refer NCTE for eligibility guidelines.

### Reservation and Relaxation

Reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government/ State Government, whichever is applicable.

### Career Opportunities/Future prospects after completion of B.Ed. Course

To become a successful professional in teaching field one should have a minimum qualification i.e. Bachelor of Education. The job opportunities for these professionals are numerous. They can find employment in various government, government aided & public institutions with a good salary package. For this recruitment the government conducts State Teacher Eligibility Test (STET) & Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) organised by CBSE/State Boards. After qualifying this examination one can join as teacher in State Government Schools, Central School, and Kendriya Vidyalyas as well as in private institutions. B.Ed. with graduation can teach at elementary & secondary level. B.Ed. with post-graduation can teach as PGT at senior secondary level. After earning a Bachelor's Degree in Education one can go in for Master in Education (M.A/M.Ed), or a Master's Degree in any subject taken at graduation level. They can also work as school counsellors as well with an added diploma in guidance.

#### Career options after B.Sc. B.Ed.

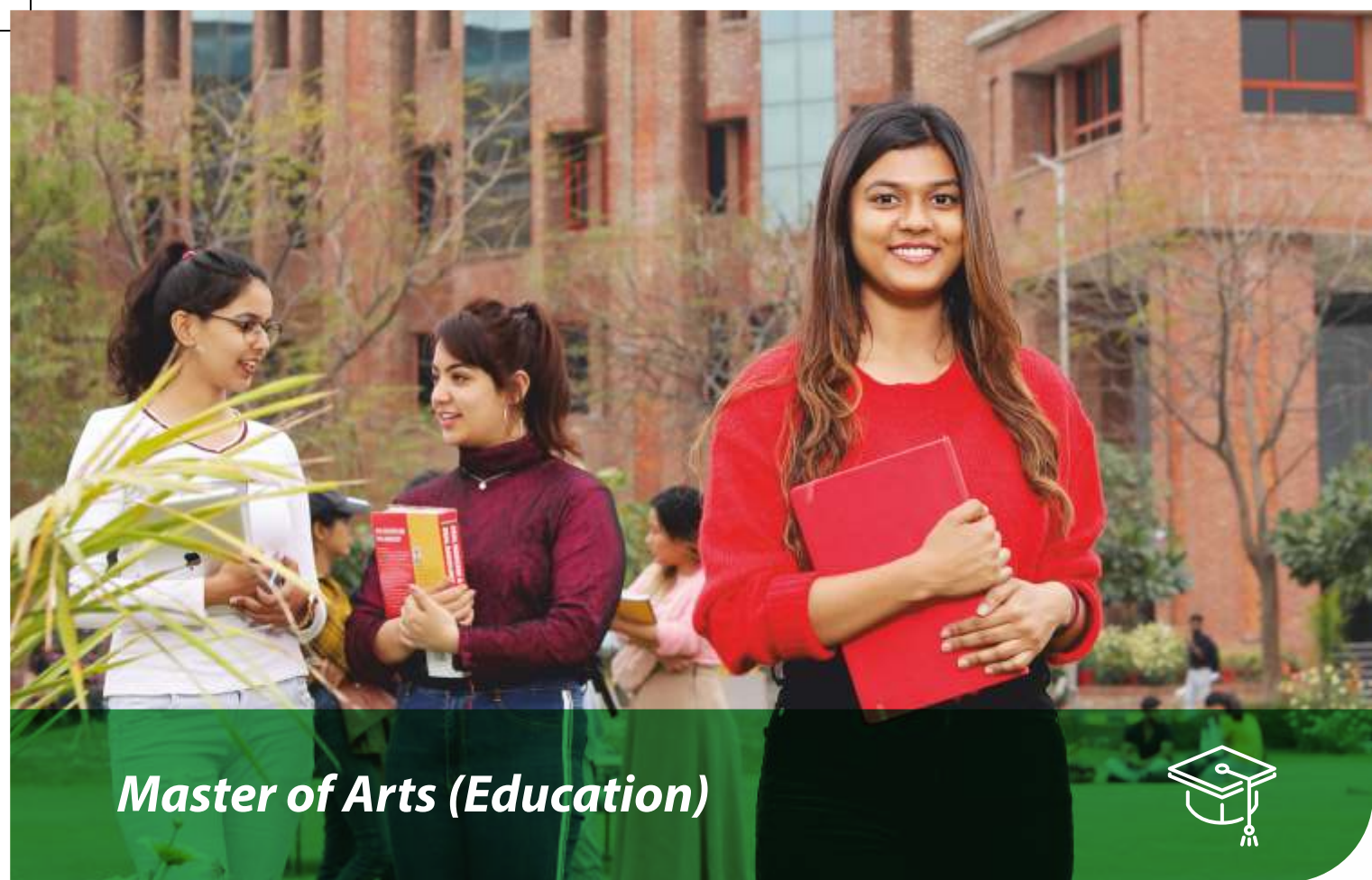
- Respected profession in the society

After earning B.Sc. B.Ed. (Medical/Non-Medical) degree they can be recruited as a science teacher in various schools. For this recruitment the government conducts State Teacher Eligibility Test (STET) & Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) organised by CBSE/State Boards. After qualifying this examination one can join as teacher in State Government Schools, Central School, and Kendriya Vidyalayas as well as in private institutions. After earning this Degree one can go in for Master in Education (M.A/M.Ed.), or a Master's Degree in any subject taken at graduation level. They can also work as school counsellors as well with an added diploma in guidance.

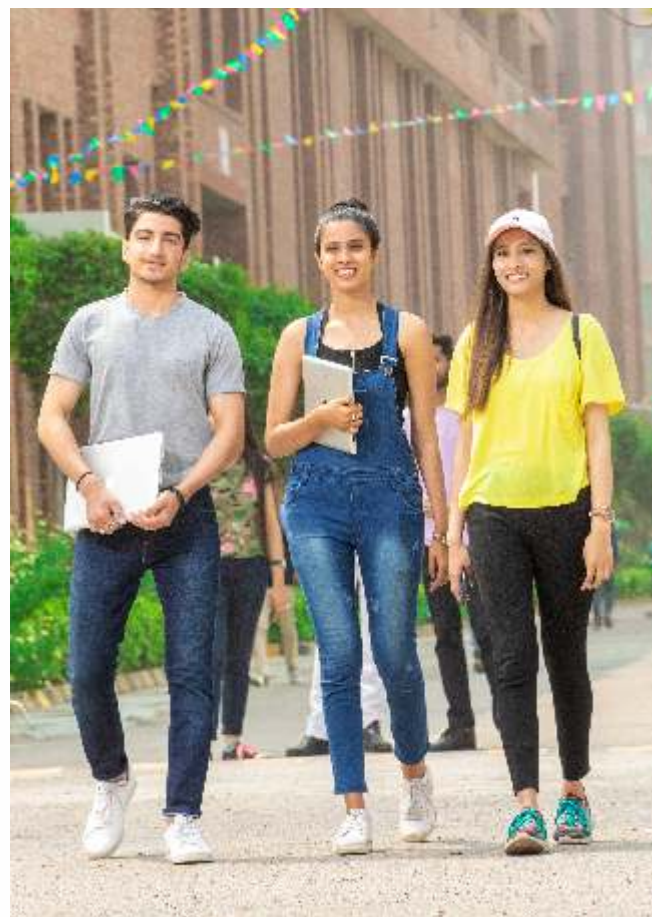

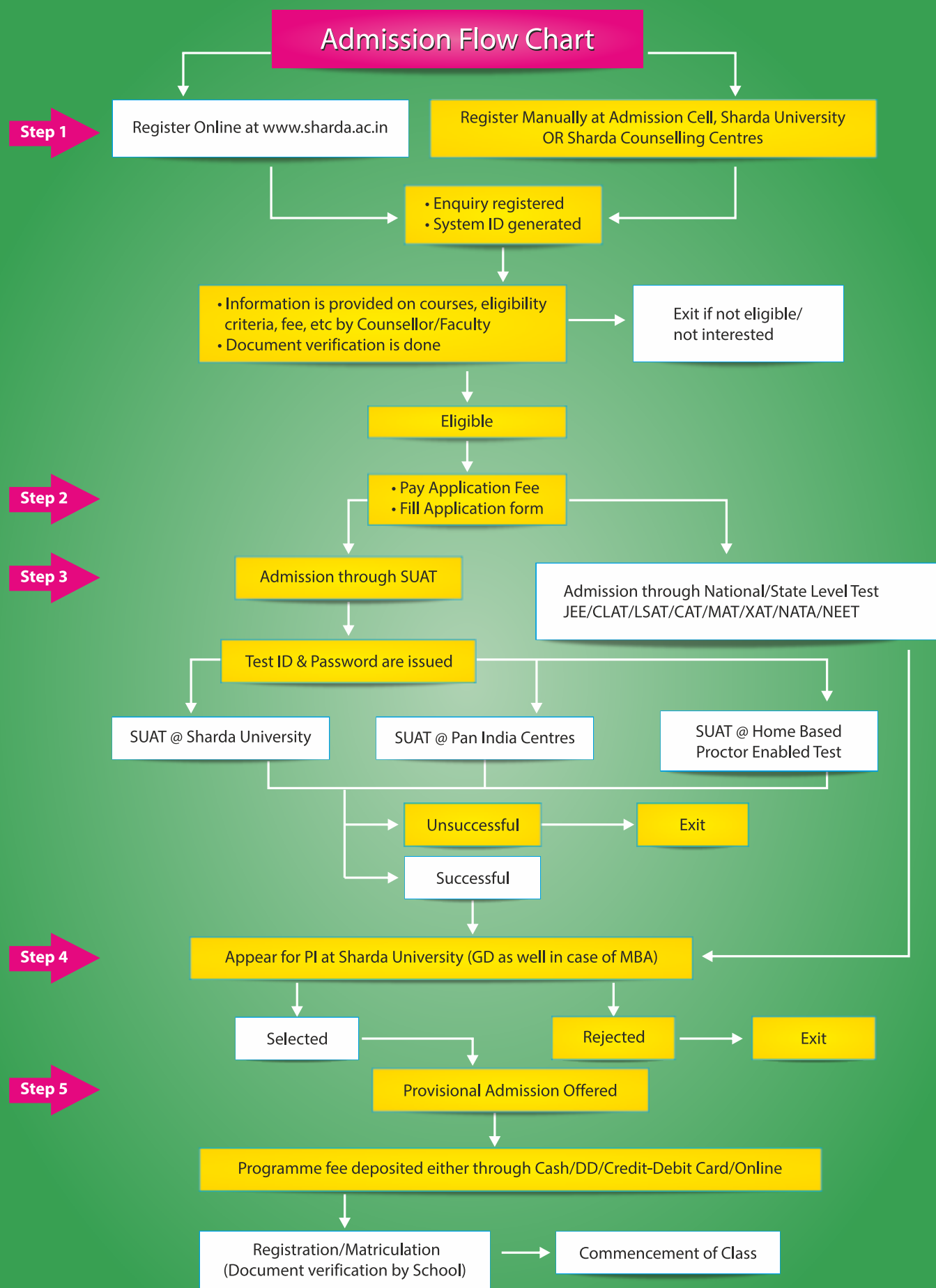
