








10 REDUCED INEQUALITIES



The aim of Sustainable Development Goal 10 is to reduce income inequality, promote social, economic, and political inclusion of all, regardless of age, sex, disability, race, ethnicity, origin, religion, or economic or other status. The Sustainable Development Goal 10 targets various forms of inequality, including those related to income, social status, gender, disability, and regions within and among the countries. II. Research Initiatives:

III. University Processes and Procedures:

Minority Cell and Social Cell:

 participation of women in leadership and academic roles. In order to empower
 women in our traditionally male-dominated society, the university offers
 programmes and support system to inspire women to seek further education
 and employment in substantial fields.
- **Global Partnerships:** Sharda University collaborates with institutions globally, sharing knowledge and best practices in reducing inequalities.

IV. Partnerships

- Sharda School of Medical Sciences and Research, Sharda University has a well-equipped skilllab with basic and advanced simulators for Basic Life Support (BLS) training and First Aid Programme. The same has been offered to the upcoming Naveen Hospital, through an MoU, for imparting training for health care workers (nursing staff, technical staff and other support staff).

In order to build solidarity and bonding among social masses, Sharda Hospital has collaborated with Fortis Hospital, Greater Noida, through a technical agreement towards securing the provisions of blood components and related services (to a level that satisfies the requirements of Blood Safety and Quality Regulations, 2005), wherein build solidarity and blood bank operating at Sharda Hospital will be assisting Fortis to meet the requirements of social and physical well-being.

 An MoU has been signed with MGM Implants, Germany, to enter into an academic partnership for acquiring knowledge regarding German implant system which will help the post graduate students in learning implantology.
