



### **5th Inter-University National Qawwali Competition**

#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- i. The theme of Qawwali shall be based on National Integration and Communal Harmony. Out of two compositions, one will be based on the theme of National Integration and Communal Harmony.
- ii. Each University will be allowed to send one team of 10 students either male or female or both.
- iii. Three accompanists (musicians) will be allowed.
- iv. The duration of performance will be 12-15 minutes.
- v. The team will be required to bring their own musical instruments.
- vi. The judgment will be based on theme, concept/idea, quality of singing, musical accompaniment; costumes etc.
- vii. The judgment of the judges will be final and binding to all the teams.

#### **PRIZES**

- ❖ First Prize: Rs. 25,000, Certificate and Trophy
- ❖ Second Prize: Rs. 20,000, Certificate and Trophy
- ❖ Third Prize: Rs. 15,000, Certificate and Trophy
- ❖ Two Consolation Prizes: Certificate and Trophy

Note: if Two Teams/Universities are on same position of Rank/Prize then the prize will be shared with two teams/Universities. In these case cash prize will be shared by the two teams/Universities but they will be honored with separate certificate and Trophy.

#### **REGISTRATION:**

Universities are requested to register their contingent either by sending email at [dsw@sharda.ac.in](mailto:dsw@sharda.ac.in) ,online on the home page of website of Sharda University, Greater Noida [www.sharda.ac.in](http://www.sharda.ac.in) and click to the **link महफ़िल-ए-खास Inter-University National Qawwali Competition**. The last date of registration is February 24, 2023. It is further requested to fill the Registration Form (Given in Annexure I & II ) and submit it along with other documents at the time of registration at the venue.

The registration desk is available at the venue Sharda University Greater Noida from February 15, 2023 (03:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.) to February 16, 2023 (08:00 a.m. to 09:00 a.m.).

The team manager of participating university must submit following documents at the time of Registration at the venue-

### **Registration Form**

- Valid Identity Card (Original) of all the participating students issued by their respective Universities (It will be given back to the team manager after checking)
- Photocopy of Valid Identity Card of all the participating students issued by their respective Universities
- Photocopy of SSC (10<sup>th</sup> Standard) Board Certificate of all the participating students
- Photocopy of Marksheet of Previously Passed Examination of all the participating students
- Fee Receipt (Original) of all the participating students (It will be given back to the team manager after checking)
- Photocopies of Fee Receipt of all the participating students
- Passport size coloured photographs of all the participating students. Accompanists. Team Managers. Cultural Coordinator. Director/Dean of Students' Welfare/Development

### **REGISTRATION FEES**

Registration fees is Rs. 1000/- per person.

For an example, if there are 15 persons in a team (including participants, accompanists and officials) consolidated participation fee would be Rs. 15000. Payment of registration fee must be made through a Bank Demand Draft (A/c Payee) drawn in favour of "**Finance and Accounts Officer, Sharda University,**" payable at Greater Noida. Universities are requested to submit the registration fees in the form of D.D. at the time of Registration at the venue

### **CAUTION MONEY**

Each Participating university has to deposit Rs. 3000/- as caution money at the time of Registration at the venue. This money is refundable. However, in case of any damage or loss of property of the University/Vendor caused by any participant/appropriate amount shall be charged and deducted from the caution money and remaining amount will be refund back to the University.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- i. The student must be full time bonafide student enrolled under University for UG / PG / M.Phil. / Ph.D. programme or any diploma course of a minimum duration of one academic year.
- ii. Casual students, external students and students pursuing only bridge course from

- University are not eligible.
- iii. Student can represent only that University from where he/she is pursuing his/her degree/diploma.
  - iv. Any disqualification of participant from the given eligibility criteria may result in removal of the contingent from the competition and the team will be debarred from Competition.
  - v. The age of participants should not be more than 27 years as on July 31, 2022.
  - vi. No student will be allowed to participate if he/she is not admitted to the University for the current academic year.

## IMPORTANT GUIDELINE FOR REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION

The participating students must carry their Identity Card issued by their respective Universities / Colleges. The team managers should submit valid Identity cards of the participants for verification at the time of registration.

The Eligibility Certificates signed by the Director / Dean / Principal of the Institute / College / and countersigned by the Dean of Students' Welfare / Cultural Coordinator / Registrar is a must and should tally with the above documents.

Age of the participants should not be more than 27 years as on 1st July.

All students will have to carry the copy of 10th STD mark sheet for age verification.

All students will have to carry the copy of 10th STD, 12th STD and mark sheets of previously passed university exam ( i.e student studying 3 rd year of college need to carry the final mark sheet of 2nd year). However, students studying 1st year of college can carry the mark sheet of 10th and 12th STD.

### REGISTRATION FEE

Registration fees is Rs 1000/- per person. For an example, if there are 15 persons in a team (including participants, accompanists and officials) consolidated participation fee would be Rs. 15000. ### CONTINGENT LEADER IN-CHARGE/ TEAM MANAGER:

A maximum of two contingent Leaders/ In Charges will accompany the team. It is advisable to have a Lady Team Manager, in case there are female participants (but the total number of the contingent should not exceed 15).

### TRAVEL PLAN

The Universities are requested to finalize their travel plan according to the Schedule. They should take a note of nearest railway stations while booking of railway tickets.

**Railway:** Sharda University is connected with Delhi Metro also nearest railway station is Delhi and Ghaziabad.

## **CONTINGENT LIMIT**

The contingent of the University should consist of Maximum fifteen (15) participants including 10 bonafide student participants, three accompanists (musicians) and two team managers (teachers).

At any case extra members accompanying the team will not be entertained. The extra members should make the arrangement of their accommodation, food and travel at their own.

## **ACCOMMODATION**

Simple type of Accommodation shall be available to all the participants. The temperature in the month of February will be in the range of 10°C to 15°C. Participants are requested to bring Cotton Cloths, light bedding, medicines, locks etc. The participants are requested not to bring valuable articles and they must take care of their belongings.

## **FOOD**

The Food will be available at the University mess as per mess timing.

## **PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES**

- Consumption of liquor
- Smoking
- Eve teasing
- Attempt to influence the judges
- Going to the press/media against the University on any controversial issue
- Indecent behavior inside and/or outside the campus and venue and at the place of stay
